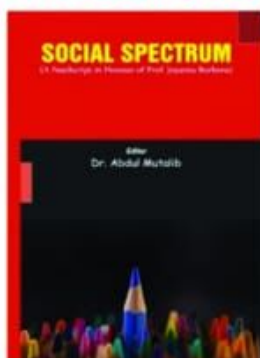

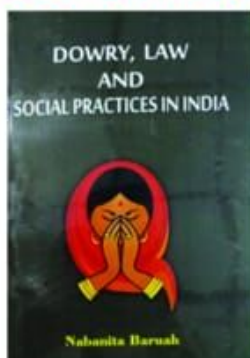

## ENERGY AUDIT

The energy audit of Silapathar College was carried out with a team of Teaching staff led by Principal and Sri. K. Talukdar, BEE, certified auditor on 30-12-2021. The energy audit was conducted to examine all the different facilities available in the college. The idea was to collect data on different appliances and utilities as well as measured the usages per item (watts indicated on the appliances) and identifying the relevant consumption patterns (like how often the appliances were used) and their impacts. Staff and students were interviewed to get better details of the usages, frequency etc.

## AWARENESS CAMPAIGN ON HAR GHAR TIRANGA-2022



In commemorating 75 years of Independence Day in India, the NSS Unit of Silapathar College observed the event in a befitting manner. To mark the event, the NSS Unit of the College carried out a number of activities from August 11th, 2022 to August 15th, 2022. 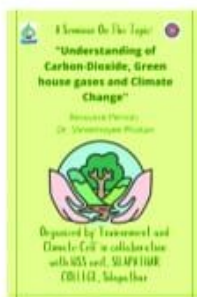


## FIELD STUDY CONDUCTED TO FULFIL COURSE REQUIREMENT- 2021-22

# CLEAN INDIA PROGRAMME

On the occasion of "Azadi ka Amrit Mahatsv", a month-long clean India programme was organised by the NSS Unit, Silapathar College, Silapathar, from October 1st to October 31st, 2021.
