### **SUMMARY OF STUDENTS FEEDBACK: 2017-2018**

The IQAC of the College collected feedback manually from students about the overall experience of the college reveals several facts. It shows the reasons for choosing the subject and satisfaction level of students in various aspects like efficiency of syllabus and curriculum, conduct of examination, the effectiveness of internal assessment and overall facilities of the College. As many as 305 students have been received from the students. In order to arrive to comprehensive results, useful statistical tools like percentage etc. have been used. For the effective presentation of the data, various types of graphs have been used. Data was collected manually from the student. Total number of 408 students responded to the survey.

### 1. STUDENT FEEDBACK ON TEACHERS

The IQAC of the College made an effort to access the student's feedback on teachers. As many as 7 questions were asked to the student on the various aspects like delivery of lectures, and availability of faculty after class hours for guidance etc.

Chart 1 describes the responses of the students on whether the teacher delivers lectures in the class effectively. It was noticed that out of 408 150 students strongly agreed that, the delivery of lectures delivered by teachers in the class room is found to be very effective. 143 students said that rated excellent, 80 nos. of students felt that the teachers were good in the class room. Only 30 nos. of students found to be satisfied in the delivery of lectures delivered by the teachers. It is noteworthy that not a single number of students dissatisfied with the mode of delivery of teachers in the class room.

Chart 2 explained the availability of faculty after class hours for guidance. It was observed that 230 students responded that, the teachers were very good by availing themselves even after the class hours. 130 numbers of students rated outstanding, 10 nos. of students felt that teachers avail themselves even after the class hours for guidance. It is disappointing that 40 nos. of students found that the teachers do not avail themselves after the class hours.

Chart 3 shows the responses on transparency & fairness of evaluation system/internal examinations. It was found that, 198 nos. of students felt that teachers were excellent in maintaining transparency and fairness of evaluation system/internal examinations, 180 nos. of students rated outstanding 30 nos. of students found good and 20 nos. of students were satisfied only. It is good only 5 nos. of students were not satisfied with the transparency and fairness of evaluation system/internal examinations.

Chart 4 provides the details on relevancy of theory to practical sessions. It was observed that 170 students rated excellent, 120 outstanding, 100 good and 20 satisfied only. 30 nos. Out of 408 respondents only 20 nos. of students were not satisfied with the relevancy of theory to practical session.

Chart 5 depicts the responses of students regarding completion of course on time. It was observed that 150 nos. of students felt that the teachers were excellent in completing their course on time, 125 nos. of students rated outstanding, 90 found to be good and 15 acceptable only.

Only 20 nos. of student's felt that the faculty of teachers do not complete course on time. The completion of course on time by the faculty members of the college is really appreciable which means that the teachers perform their duties diligently.

Chart 6 reveals that the teachers deliberately disburse their course in the classroom.

Chart 7 explains the degree of satisfaction with conference/seminars. It was observed that the responses of students to this were found to be very good.

#### 2. STUDENT FEEDBACK ON OTHER FACILITIES OF THE COLLEGE

Chart 8 gives the details of educational visits of students conduct by the college. It was noticed that 200 students rated good, 40 excellent, 30 outstanding and 145was satisfied only.

The observation shows that the role of college in conducting educational visits is really appreciable.

Chart 9 shows the students on Career Counseling provided by the College. It was found that 180 students have said good, 20% outstanding, 40 excellent and 130 said that it was acceptable only. Notably, 10 nos. of students have said that the Career Counselling provided by the college to be poor.

Chart 10 depicts the responses of the students on the adequate and effective use of teaching aids. It was noticed that 155% students have said that the teachers have the adequate knowledge of using teaching aids in the class room is good, 60 nos. felt that the teaching aids use by the teacher in the class room excellent, and 37 outstanding. It is disappointing to note that 140 nos. of students felt that most of the teachers do not use the teaching aids properly in the classroom.

Chart 11 revels that the College has a conducive atmosphere for teaching- learning process as well greenery campus. Only 10 nos. of students felt that the college does not have good environment for teaching- learning.

Chart 12 shows the responsiveness of the issues by administrative Departments, (Principal, Vice-Principal, Head of Department, Library Staff, Office Staff, Gate Keeper). The pie chart revealed that 150 nos. of students have said that the administrative Departments, (Principal, Vice-Principal, Head of Department, Library Staff, Office Staff, Gate Keeper responded and behaved well, 55 nos. outstanding, 130 good and 5 nos. were satisfied only acceptable and 25 nos. of students rated that the teachers were not responsive by the administrative departments to the issues raised by the students.

Chart 13, 14 & 15 identifies that rules for late payment of fees, penalty for library charges and fee structure is good.

Chart 16 shows that the college regularly updates the notice board. 230 students rated outstanding, 120 excellent, 30 good and 40 nos. of students said that it was acceptable only. Notably, zero percent has rated that the college do not update the notice board regularly.

Chart 17 describes the Politeness and Support of the staff. It was observed that 140 students have rated excellent, 125 good, 70 outstanding and 70 satisfied. Only 20 students felt that the staffs do not behave politely with them.

Chart 18 & 19 explains on cleanliness of class room, hostel, laboratory, Library, corridors, toilets, drinking water and general area. Majority of the students felt that they are having well equipped library facility properly maintained the classroom, toilets facility good, drinking water available and the general environment conducive.

Chart: 20 show the overall all canteen facility of the college. 140 students have felt that the food and beverages available in the canteen was acceptable to some extent only, 130 have rated good, 90 students excellent and o students have rated outstanding. Notably, 60 nos. of students have said that they were not satisfied with the food of the students.

Chart 21 explains on the security inside the College campus. It is observed that most of the students were not satisfied with the security provision of the college.

Chart 22 & 23 give details on the facilities of parking and computer available in the college campus. The overall rating in theses points as average.
